- Your child was identified to participate in the DUKE Tip Program based on being enrolled in either Pre-AP Math or Pre-AP English.
- Please keep in mind that this program is optional and is not organized by Hill Country Middle School. You can get more information at www.tip.duke.edu. Please keep in mind; this is an optional program. If your child chooses to participate, he/she will be testing with Juniors and Seniors in high school.
- If you want your child to participate, you will need to do the following things:
 1. Register **either** online (www.tip.duke.edu/7enroll) or through the mail.
 2. *Paper Registration: Section 9: Write in “Coordinator Recommendation” on number 14. Then bubble 95% under the composite section.*
Online Registration: Select “Coordinator Recommendation” on the Qualifying Test drop down menu.
 3. The school I.D. number is **802900-JB**.
 4. Visit www.tip.duke.edu/7testcenters to find the test center of your choice.

3.0 to 3.5 Hours Long	3 Hours and 50 Minutes Long
4 Sections: English, Math, Reading, & Science	3 Sections: Critical Reading, Math, Writing (includes essay)
36 possible points on each section	800 possible points on each section
