- 3. Complete final exam to demonstrate mastery at 70% or higher for each semester
- 4. Complete the EOC exams for required State courses when offered

Permission to complete an Online or Correspondence Course is a privilege. These expectations must be met if the student is to profit from this instructional arrangement.

Information regarding the completed course:

- Course will not appear in the student's schedule
- Percent mastery grade will appear on the student's official high school transcript but will not be calculated into the weighted GPA
- The grade earned in an online course <u>does not</u> affect eligibility for "no pass/no play"
- Correspondence/online courses do not meet NCAA requirements
