- Foreign Language (2 credits)
- PE (1 credit)
- Health (½ credit)
- Electives of interest (5.5 credits); all courses that go above graduation requirements are considered electives – i.e. 5th year of math, additional fine arts or athletics credits

- Login to Family Access.
- Select **Career Plan** on the left.
- Near the top right, click "View Full Screen."
- **Add your courses** for next year by clicking the "Add Curriculum" button.
 - In the search bar on the lower right you can type in a course number or keyword; click "save" and repeat for the rest of next year's courses AND all remaining years of high school.
- Provide your **electronic signature** (at the top left, click the tiny link next to your name that says "sign") – this is required by State law. **A parent must also login and sign electronically.**
- The deadline to complete your Career Plan in Skyward is **March 4, 2019.**

DID YOU KNOW ... Automatic admission to a Texas public college or university is granted to students who are in the top 10% of their graduating class* and who complete the distinguished level of achievement (4 years of study in core areas, including Algebra 2), plus an endorsement. *UT is allowed to select a smaller percentage.
